

The bastard's feast

9 july - 24 september 2023

Hélène Bertin and Yusuf Henni present The bastard's feast, in reference to the wild hybridization of the differents varieties of calabash (in Provence the term «coucourdon» is used to say calabash) and of the intrument crated at this occasion, both percussion and chordophone, mixed from two materials; ceramics and gourds.

The meeting of the two artists, one a ceramicist, the other who works with calabash, mixed their preferred materials; the cclay of Bolène, symbolically situated halfway betweenthe living places of the two artists, and the calabash cultivated in Yusuf's garden since 2017. Here the assemblies make apparent complementarities and links: colors, textures, sounds... otherendemic materials are harvested in their respective landscapes: juniper wood, hazel wood, sticks from Provence...

The adventureis structured around the preparation of a young canivalesque tradition; the «Charivari» at Saint Ferréol-trente-pas (drôme), the duo is working on a sequence of objects that feeds the edition of april 2023. A series of masks where created at Cucuron (Luberon), then cooked at «La Borne» (fr). The mett between clay and calabash gave birth to crazy instruments, that will be presented on the feast table. In between the two «Charivari», this exhibition resume one edition and prepares the following one. They have created a sceptor of procession by using the strings of the iris leaves, pearls ans medals, an oven forfiring the items at Upie (fr) and finally a moon that will guide the «Charivarist» in 2024.

Hélène and Yusuf contributed to many «Charivari», organized two gigs, one for the firing in the noborigama oven, he other with Loup Uberto for the opening of the exhibition. The creation projects are an opportunity for them to create events that will form links between people. This isprecisely what connects them.

From the exhibition emerges a manual approach and proposes a reinterpretation of thisadventure, made so that everyone can take hold of it. This is an invitation!
